



The Professors' Association Umeå (Professorsföreningen i Umeå)

The Professors' Association Umeå was established in 1968, only three years after the establishment of the university, as a part of what is today the Swedish Association of University Teachers and Researchers (SULF). It is today Sweden's oldest Professors' Association of its kind.

From the start, the association has focused on interdisciplinary cooperation across what was initially a small campus, which over time came to encompass Sweden's third largest university (Umeå university) as well as the Faculty of Forestry of the Swedish University of Agricultural Sciences (SLU). As an interest organisation for all professors in Umeå who are SULF members, the association forwards the professional interests of its members through activities on current research policy issues such as ethics assessment, academic freedom, and research data, by arranging seminars and contributing within SULF and university contexts.

The board of the association generally includes participation from all faculties at Umeå university, as well as adjoined members from the faculty at SLU Umeå and the emeritus professors' association in Umeå. Seminars are open to all, and all professors who are members of SULF at Umeå university are invited to the annual meeting that is usually held early June.
